Rachael Marsh is Chief Legal Officer at the Edison Electric Institute (EEI), leading EEI's legal and energy policy and corporate counsel teams.

Prior to joining EEI, Marsh was Vice President, Government Affairs and Managing Counsel at Calpine. Based in Washington, D.C., she helped Calpine navigate the complex legal, regulatory, and legislative federal landscape.

Marsh was previously a partner at Bracewell LLP, where she represented a range of energy companies—including competitive power suppliers, renewable developers, utilities, and pipelines—in matters before the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) and state regulators.

From 2014 to 2021, Marsh served as an attorney at FERC, including as legal advisor to the Chairman. Prior to her legal career, Marsh held roles in the Office of the Governor of Texas and at the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

Marsh holds degrees from the University of Texas School of Law, Harvard University's Kennedy School of Government, and Texas Tech University.
