Emily Schillinger is Chief Communications Officer at the Edison Electric Institute (EEI), leading EEI's communications team.

Prior to joining EEI, Schillinger served as Executive Vice President of Public Affairs for the American Investment Council (AIC). In this role, she developed and led AIC's comprehensive communications and media affairs strategy.

She previously served for more than 15 years at the highest levels of government at the White House, the U.S. Senate, and the U.S. House of Representatives.

Most recently, she served as Communications Director of the House Ways & Means Committee, where she advised members of the committee and led the committee's communications strategy for the successful passage of the historic Tax Cuts and Jobs Act.

Before joining the Ways & Means Committee, Schillinger served as Press Secretary to Speaker of the House John Boehner. Prior to this, she served as Communications Director to U.S. Senator John Barrasso and the Senate Republican Policy Committee.

Earlier in her career, Schillinger served in the George W. Bush Administration as Press Secretary at the U.S. Department of Commerce and as Assistant Press Secretary at the White House.

Schillinger grew up in Columbus, Ga., and holds a bachelor's degree from Clemson University.
